Below you will find an outline of the current Covid-19 plans for the 2021-22 school year for ACEA. Plans are subject to change in order to provide for the health and safety our students and staff:

- We are emphasizing in-person instruction this year as we look to accelerate learning lost from last year's Covid related absences.
- Virtual learning is provided on a case-by-case basis, according to the needs of individual students.
- Every student is health screened for a fever, upon entering the building.
- Masks are required on school buses—per CDC.
- Vaccinations for staff and students over the age of 12 are recommended by the CDC, but not required at ACEA, at this time.
